Driving Privilege Guidelines

- Students must have a valid Georgia Driver's License.
- Students must present a current tag registration.
- The parking pass sticker must be displayed on the driver's side rear window.
- Students must follow all school driving and parking guidelines, posted signs, traffic flow patterns, speed limits, and directions from school staff or administration.
- Speeding, reckless driving, burnouts, cutting through traffic, or unsafe driving on school grounds will be considered a violation of parking guidelines.
- Students may not rev up engines, accelerate loudly, play loud music, or create unnecessary vehicle noise on campus.
- Parking in any area other than the student's designated parking space is prohibited.
- Students must leave their vehicle upon arriving at school and may not return to their vehicle unless authorized by an administrator.
- Vehicles are subject to search if there is reasonable suspicion the student is in possession of an item that is illegal or against school rules.
- Students are not allowed to ride on the outside of any vehicle, including the back of pickup trucks.
- Students may not leave/check out with other students who are not siblings.
- Illegal reproduction of parking stickers is prohibited.
- Written permission from a parent/guardian and front office approval are required before a student may check out and drive off campus. Leaving without approval is considered cutting/skipping class and will be handled accordingly.
- **Excessive tardiness/absences** may result in the loss of permit for a length of time determined by the administration.
- If a parking permit is suspended and the student drives on campus, parking privileges may be revoked for the remainder of the year, with no refund.
- When a permanent change of vehicle occurs, the student has 3 days to obtain a new sticker for \$5.00.
- If a vehicle other than the one listed above is driven, the student must notify the front office immediately.
- The initial cost for a parking pass is \$60. After January 1, 2027, the cost is \$30 for the remainder of the school year.
- Academic Honors parking is \$40 for qualified seniors. A 3.75 unweighted GPA is required.
- Students may not loan, share, or sell their parking sticker to anyone.
- Students are subject to having their parking pass revoked if they cut in front of a school bus as it enters or exits the parking lot.
- If a student withdraws from FBHS or enrolls in the Hall County Virtual Program, they will not be issued a refund, and their spot may be reassigned.

DRIVING TO SCHOOL IS A PRIVILEGE – NOT A RIGHT.

Violations of these guidelines may result in the following:

- Loss of permit for a specified amount of time.
- In-School Suspension
- Towing of vehicle
- Suspension from school.

DRUG-TESTING ADMINISTRATION ACKNOWLEDGEMENT/CONSENT FORM

The Hall County Board of Education has authorized mandatory random drug tests for all student-athletes who participate in Georgia High School Association (GHSA) interscholastic athletics and **all students who obtain a campus parking permit.**

1. The student must present to the school administration this signed consent form, which authorizes the school to administer drug testing and allows the results of the test to be released to parents or guardians, administrative officials, and the head coach. **(Note: A signed consent form is a requirement to obtain a parking permit and for participation in any interscholastic activity. Parents and students do not have the option of not participating in the drug-screen program.)**
2. Random testing will take place at any time during the year with students chosen through lottery/random selection. Testing consists of providing a urine sample to representatives of the firm administering the test. School personnel will supervise but will not administer the test. Privacy will be protected. Specimens will be processed for identity and secured to ensure against tampering. Test results will be reported to the school through the proper chain of command. In the case of a positive result, the parent or guardian will be notified and the student will no longer be allowed to drive/park a vehicle at the school and will be disciplined at the discretion of administration.

Testing will be done by the Northeast Georgia Forensic/Toxicology Lab under the supervision of the Toxicology Program Manager.

This acknowledgement of administration and consent to allow participation in the random drug-testing program shall remain in effect until revoked in writing.
