Senior Painted Parking Spot Guidelines & Agreement 2026-2027

Eligible seniors may apply for a designated senior parking spot that may be painted and personalized for the school year. This is a privilege and must be handled responsibly, respectfully, and in accordance with all FBHS expectations.

Painting Dates

Primary Painting Day	Thursday, July 30, 2026, 9:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. Friday, July 31, 2026, 9:00 a.m. – 4:00 pm
Make-Up Day	Saturday, August 1, 2026, 9:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.
Important	Students may only paint during approved times unless granted prior administrative approval.

Flowery Branch High School is excited to provide senior students with the opportunity to express school spirit by allowing them to personalize their assigned parking spot in the designated senior parking lot. This opportunity is a privilege for seniors and must be handled responsibly, respectfully, and in accordance with all Flowery Branch High School and Hall County Schools expectations.

Senior painted parking spots are limited and will be assigned on a first-come, first served basis once all required forms, approvals, and payments have been completed. Students cannot request a particular parking space from the list of designated senior parking spaces that are available for painting. If students would like to have parking spaces next to each other, they must come together to purchase their spots in order to get spots next to each other. Once the spaces available are full, there will not be any additional spaces available. Please come early to purchase your spots

Seniors who do not wish to paint their parking spot may still complete the standard FBHS parking application and receive a reserved parking space.

REQUIREMENTS

1. All senior students who wish to park on campus in a painted senior parking spot must complete the FBHS parking permit application and this Senior Painted Parking Spot Agreement.
2. Students must meet all standard parking requirements, including:
 - o Valid Georgia Driver's License
 - o Current tag registration
 - o Proof of insurance
 - o Completion of required drug-testing consent form
 - o Completion of all required FBHS parking documents
 - o Payment of all required parking fees
3. Students must understand and comply with all FBHS parking guidelines, school driving expectations, and student handbook expectations.
4. Parking permits are not transferable between students. Students may not loan, share, sell, or give their parking permit or assigned space to another student.
5. The current year parking permit must be properly displayed while the vehicle is on campus.

PAINTING INFORMATION

PAINTING DAY

Thursday, July 30, 2026 and Friday, July 31, 2026
9:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.

MAKE-UP PAINTING DAY

Saturday, August 1, 2026
9:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.

All painting must be completed during the approved painting times listed above. Students may not paint before or after the approved dates without administrative permission.

Students must begin painting early enough to complete the spot during the approved painting window. Any unfinished parking spots may be required to remain as-is or be painted over at the discretion of administration.

The senior parking lot may be closed to student traffic during painting times. Students and families should park in a designated area during painting.

NO ONE will be allowed inside the building for any reason. Please make sure to bring stuff to rinse your paintbrushes outside. Bring coolers with water and tents to allow you to stay outside while painting

In the event of bad weather, FBHS administration may adjust the painting schedule and communicate updates to students and families.

PAINTING REQUIREMENTS

1. Students must purchase and bring their own paint and supplies.
2. Students should bring all materials needed, including paint, brushes, rollers, painter's tape, chalk, water, trash bags, and clean-up supplies.
3. Students must use water-based, exterior latex paint only.
4. If the assigned spot has not been painted before, students are encouraged to begin with a primer coat or background coat so the design will look its best.
5. If the assigned spot has already been painted, students are encouraged to begin with the background color
6. The following materials are prohibited:
 - Spray paint
 - Oil-based paint
 - Striping paint
 - Raised paint
 - Roofing tar
 - Reflective paint
 - Fluorescent paint
 - Glitter paint
 - Clear coat or sealant
 - Adhesives or materials that may damage school property
7. All designs must remain within the assigned parking space and must stay at least 3 inches away from all parking space lines and borders.
8. Paint may not cover the parking spot number. The parking spot number must remain clearly visible at all times.
9. Students may not paint over parking lines, curbs, sidewalks, grass, fire lanes, handicap markings, traffic markings, walls, or any area outside the assigned parking spot.
10. Students may not paint another student's parking spot or alter another student's design.
11. Students may not switch parking spots without administrative approval.
12. Students must clean up their area before leaving campus. All paint cans, brushes, rollers, tape, trash, and supplies must be removed from campus.
13. Paint and supplies may not be left on campus.
14. Parents/guardians may assist with painting, but the senior student must be present during the painting process.
15. Do not leave a mess when you leave.

DESIGN GUIDELINES

All designs must be school-appropriate and must reflect positively on Flowery Branch High School. Designs may include student names, graduation year, school spirit, positive messages, college or career themes, activities, clubs, sports, or appropriate personal interests.

The following designs are prohibited:

1. Offensive language, pictures, symbols, or images.
2. Profanity, vulgar language, or inappropriate wording.

3. Negative, rude, or disrespectful language.
 4. Gang-style tagging or gang-related symbols.
 5. Double meanings, jokes, or phrases that may be interpreted as inappropriate.
 6. References to drugs, alcohol, tobacco, vaping, weapons, violence, or illegal activity.
 7. Sexual content, suggestive language, or inappropriate images.
 8. Political statements, controversial messages, or symbols that may create disruption.
 9. Graphics, logos, album covers, brands, or characters that may represent inappropriate content for school.
 10. Any wording, symbol, image, or design that violates FBHS or Hall County Schools policies and guidelines.
 11. Any design that FBHS administration determines may cause a disruption to the learning environment or does not align with school expectations.
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MAINTENANCE AND SCHOOL PROPERTY

1. Parking spaces, painted or not, remain the property of Flowery Branch High School and Hall County Schools.
 2. FBHS administration may cover, reassign, repaint, or remove a painted parking space at any time.
 3. FBHS is not responsible for fading, tire marks, weather damage, vandalism, paint damage, or damage caused by other vehicles.
 4. Students are responsible for maintaining the appearance of their painted parking spot throughout the school year.
 5. If a design becomes inappropriate, damaged, altered, or does not match the approved design, the student may be required to repaint or cover the spot at the student's expense.
 6. Students who do not comply with the painting requirements may be directed to paint over their space at the discretion of FBHS administration.
 7. At the end of the school year, students may be required to paint over or restore the parking spot if directed by administration.
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CONSEQUENCES FOR VIOLATIONS

Failure to follow these guidelines may result in one or more of the following:

- Required repainting or covering of the parking spot at the student's expense - \$100.00 dollars
 - Loss of painted parking spot privilege
 - Loss of parking permit for a specified amount of time
 - Revocation of parking privileges with no refund
 - Disciplinary consequences
 - Towing of vehicle
 - Suspension from school
